DESIGN BASED ON EXPERIENCE

Fast, elegant, and safe, ensuring a fully pleasant sailing experience. The DS 24 has been designed to optimize cockpit space for comfortable trips. Its easy-handling features make it suitable for sailors of any experience level.

The draft preserves its boatyard spirit and can be lifted from 4 feet 7 inches to 1 foot 8 inches, making it a fully trailerable sailboat due to its lifting appendages, mast on a folding deck, and low displacement.

The Z24DS is now available in a racing version, specially designed for those who enjoy fast cruising and quick sailing reactions. The Sail Area/Displacement (SA/D) ratio has increased due to a larger sail surface and lower displacement. In the case of lower displacement, weight has been reduced by using biaxial and unidirectional fabrics in the hull, deck, and interior, as well as by replacing solid panels with the sandwich system. The improvement in the SA/D ratio signifies the attainment of a fast and powerful performance sailboat, regardless of the wind level experienced.

The rudder is made of epoxy resin and E-glass fibers, and an optional keel with a lead bulb is available while maintaining the lifting keel format.

The outstanding features described above confirm that the Z24DS exceeds sailors' expectations within the 24-foot segment

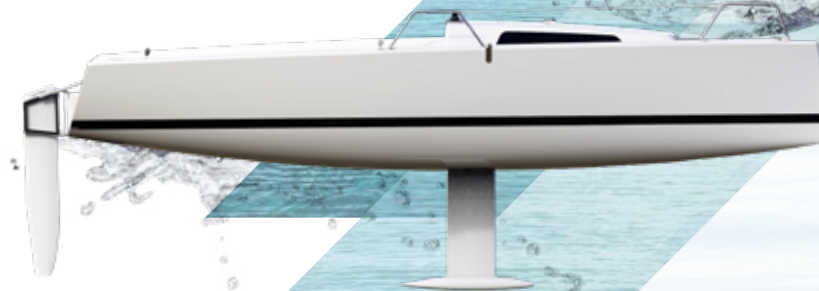

The Z24DS is a 23'8" daysailer with modern interior and exterior lines. It is designed as a trailerable daysailer that satisfies the needs of those who navigate with no elevation means.

Its lifting keel of 4'7" in the lower position and 1'8" in the higher position contributes to easy manipulation and mobility of the sailboat. Comfort, easy cruising, and stability are some of the characteristics that make the Z24DS a remarkable sailing boat.

The spacious and stylish interiors are the perfect combination to rest, spend the night, or shelter during bad weather. This craft has an innovative engine drawer in its cockpit, which allows outboards engines between 3 and 6 hp. As a result, you get a storage space without exposure to the weather, not at sight, clean, and easy to operate.

Z24DS is prepared to use either a self-tacking jib or a conventional genoa. The self-tacking jib is perfect for sailing on your own. The concept of this sailboat is to create a wonderful place to spend time afloat, no matter the weather condition or the crew with whom you choose to travel.
